Feedback work as the mirror in the self-assessment of the duties and responsibilities of the institute to concern elements about students. The facilities provided by the institute like infrastructure, labs and equipment's, official support plays considerable role in the process of teaching and learning. The feedback on curriculum is necessary for learning values and applicability or relevance of the course. Under the kind guidance of the Principal Prof. Dr. P. V. Dalal the feedback committee of four persons Mr. V. D. Patil (Chairman), Mr. S. B. Dhanale (Member) Dr. L. C. Nemade (Member), Mr. N. A. Ghule (Member) was formed as per guidance of the Principal and IQAC Coordinator Dr. S. R. Chaudhari it is decided to take six types of feedback as

1. Student's feedback on curriculum.
2. Teacher's feedback on curriculum.
3. Teacher's evaluation by students.
4. Parent's feedback on facilities provided by institute.
5. Alumina feedback about the institute and applicability of the course.
6. Student satisfactory survey.

The online method to collect feedback and questionnaires included in the feedback are finalized by the Principal. While submitting this feedback analysis report to the institute we all persons of the committee have great pleasure and we wish to pay our big gratitude to Principal Prof. Dr. P. V. Dalal, IQAC Coordinator Dr. S. R. Chaudhari and Vice Principal Dr. V. B. Suryawanshi for their time to time valuable guidance.

Here committee found that over all curriculum is excellent with respective learning values of course content, applicability/relevance of the course, length of the course, clarity and accessibility of study material also here we have to not that equal percentage of students prefer online and offline methods of teaching and learning process. More than 70% students says that there is academic loss during the pandemic period of Covide-19. In case of teachers almost every teacher says that syllabus is excellent and very good about suitability of the syllabus to the course aims and objective of the syllabus, balance between theory and practical, availability of updated reference material. It is not observed that some teacher from any one subject is not satisfied about some aspect of syllabus. Half of the teachers are agree with 40% online and 60% offline teaching method. Here committee found that almost all parents are well satisfied about the facilities provided by the institute, cooperation and help of teaching and non-teaching



staff to their pupil. According to the alumina feedback they got very good experience in the institute. Most of them says that they got carrier enhancement during the course, the curriculum was designed to their intelligent scope, their social relationship communication skill and personality is developed, The curriculum was applicable to real life situation. 75% alumina says that institute works properly to overall development of students.
